- Qualifications: Maximum 45 contestants If more than 45 contestants entered top 50 blended CPRA/PRCA/WPRA standings as of August 8, 2022 will be used to determine draw outs. If the qualifications are not filled by contestants with dollars won leaving open positions; the remaining openings will be filled by a random draw of card holders then semi-pro card holders. If there are still open positions, all remaining openings will be filled by a random draw of permit holders.
