Draws:

- Draw #1 will be all entries entered by June 15th midnight. Draw #1 will be posted June 18th, www.saddlebook.com/events/4270
- Draw #2 will be all entries from June 16th -June 21st at midnight and posted June 22nd, www.saddlebook.com/events/4270
- Additional draws will be done at the event as needed.

Late Entries:

- Will be accepted via www.saddlebook.com/events/4270 up to the last 20 runs both days.
- Late entries after June 1st are subject to a \$25 late fee.
- If pre entered and enter another horse after books close you will incur a late fee on the additional horse.
- One late fee per rider max.

Refunds:

- Draw outs before June 1st will not require a vet/medical release.
- Draw outs after June 1st will require a vet/medical release before June 23rd.
- If refund is needed weekend of race, see the vet on site to get a vet slip.
- Refunds will be mailed after completion of race with a vet/medical release.
- Horse substitution is allowable and must notify the office with the registered name of the sub horse prior to competing.
- Full refunds less credit card & check/processing fees for stalls and RVs with no cut-off date. Prior notice must be given.
- No shows will not be refunded

Open 5D:

- Course measurements will be posted at the office. 5D Format .5, 1, 1.5 & 2 sec splits.
- 75% payback.
- Open awards for average on Friday, Saturday and Sunday combined. Must be present or notify office that you have someone available to receive your award and be available for sponsor pictures. Must be in dress code.

Stalls:

- Reserve Stalls via www.saddlebook.com/events/4270
- Stalls are required for \$35 per night. Stalls cannot be resold to another person.
- Stalls are fully refundable
- No overnight tying to trailers or pens, per the facility.
- If you are arriving late you must purchase stalls in advance of arrival. Unless reserved and paid for, stalls will be locked.

Shavings:

- No outside shavings per facility.
- Stalls will include 1 bag of shavings
- Additional bags can be pre purchased and will be available onsite for \$10 per bag.

Parking/Camping:

- RV Hook ups are \$35 per night. RV's cannot be resold to another person
- RV's are fully refundable
- RV spaces are limited and are on a first paid, first served basis.
- No charge for dry camping
- Once RV spots are sold out we will set up Spider Box (power) reservations. Spider Boxes will NOT SUPPORT your A/C units without blowing breakers. We will contact you to ask you if you want to proceed with the reservation or obtain a refund, if you choose to proceed you must adhere to the A/C rule per the facility.
- PAID RV signs will be given upon check in at the office, these are to be placed in your vehicle or trailer window throughout the event.

Payouts:

- Will be mailed the following week of the event upon receipt of completed W9.
- Any balances owed will result in payoff checks being held.
- Please be sure your correct mailing address is in Saddlebook when entering, this address will be used to mail checks.

Multiple riders:

Horses cannot be run by multiple riders on same class/day.

\$10,000 added Select Stallion Stakes Open Incentive:

- Horses must be enrolled as Select Stallion Stakes progeny.
- To check if your horse is enrolled go to selectstallionstakes.com.
- \$5,000 added Saturday
- \$5,000 added Sunday

Pee Wee:

- 10 & under as of Jan. 1st 2023.
- Champion buckle to 1st, Jackpot only, no awards.
- Pee Wee cannot enter the Open 5D.

SIDE POTS

Judge Cash Side Pot:

- 4D option with ½ second splits.
- \$500 added

Youth:

- 18 and under as of Jan 1st 2023.
- 4D payout, ½ second splits.

Senior:

- 50 and over as of Jan 1st 2023.
- 4D payout, ½ second splits.

Your Barrel Connection (YBC) Side Pot:

- 4D option with ½ second splits.
- www.bestofbarrelsonly.com

Lucky #7 Side Pot:

• 3D format with .7 sec splits off fastest side pot 1D time.

Got A Little Tipsy Side Pot:

- Downed barrel(s) insurance pot.
- 3D format with .7 splits off the fastest time with a hit barrel(s).

Exhibitions:

- Will be in a Group Riding format.
- 15 min. intervals with 5 spaces/riders available per time slot.
- \$20 per slot.
- If slots fill we will have a Group Riding waitlist on Saddlebook. If a Group Ride becomes available we will contact in order with the time available.
- No refunds on exhibitions.
- Rider can sell their slot to someone else but must notify Pat at turnnburnbarrelracing@gmail.com.
- For day of exhibitions, please check with gate person for availability and purchase of Group Riding Slots. No exceptions.

No Time:

Contestants will receive a no time for knocking a barrel or pole over or breaking the pattern.

Timers:

- An electric timer will be used.
- Reruns will be given only in the event of a timer malfunction.
- If a rerun is given, the contestant will choose from two options and they must notify staff with rerun choice immediately.
 - Option 1- Run in the next available vet out/draw out position or;
 - Option 2 Run at the end of the race.

Drags:

There will be a tractor drag after every 5 drawn runs

- Big drag after every 50 drawn.
- Turn outs and releases will be included in the draw.
- The ground may be reworked at anytime at the discretion of The Showdown committee for the safety of everyone.

Disqualification:

- Contestants must be ready when called. Failure to be in position in the holding area will result in a disqualification.
- Contestants must be in holding pen during your drag.
- If a horse is run out of order, it will be disqualified.
- Announcer will call rider name three times, failure to be ready after 3rd call will be a disqualification.

Concessions:

The Rim Rock Café will be open Friday, Saturday and Sunday for your convenience.

Non-registered vendors:

- Will be charged double the regular vendor fee and disqualified without refunds if competing at the event.
- Providing any goods or services onsite is considered vending and is not allowed without registration. No
 exceptions. This is to provide equity to the paying vendors supporting the race.

Dogs:

- Dogs must be on a leash at all times.
- No dogs in the arena.

RULES SPECIFIC TO KK RUN FOR VEGAS

Hat Fine:

• \$20 hat fine imposed once hat is lost in Poles and Barrels. Hat fine proceeds will be donated to the Humane Society of the Ochocos.

Pole Bending:

- Must enter online at <u>www.saddlebook.com</u> on the KK Run for Vegas event.
- If you qualify for Vegas you will need to be on the arena floor immediately after the round for pictures in dress code.

Barrels:

- Must enter online at <u>www.saddlebook.com</u> on the KK Run for Vegas event.
- All KK Run For Vegas barrel entries are required to enter and carry their time to the Showdown in the Cascades Saturday Open 5D.
- When you enter the KK Run For Vegas you will be able to click the link to the Showdown in the Cascades race.
- If you qualify for Vegas you will need to be on the arena floor immediately after the round for pictures in dress code.
