- **8.** If there is tie for top 12, fastest time of the two runs advances to finals.
- 9. All performances and Monday Finals, tractor rake after actual 6 runs.
- 10. Tractor drag will be condensed per WPRA Rule 12.8.2.1.1. All notified turn outs and Releases from each performance and slack will be taken out of the draw after the out deadline. Positions will move up and be posted at the rodeo office before the rodeo begins. I.E. If you are number 9 and there are 2 releases prior to you, you will be draw number 7. Committee will drag at 5 or fewer if set up for 10, 6 or fewer if set up for 12.
