Cut-off date for standings: September 30, 2022

Who: The California Divisional Finals will consist of the top 12 in the standings WHO HAVE ENTERED THE EVENT. All cardholders (even if below the 12th position) are encouraged to enter, as we often have to go further down into the standings to fill the 12 spots. The Junior Finals will also consist of the top 12. As above, anyone below the top 12 may enter, as YOU MUST SEND IN AN ENTRY TO BE ELIGIBLE TO FILL AN OPEN POSITION.

**New for 2022 - we will be having an OPEN Permit Finals this year, meaning that ANY permit holder (2022 or 2023) may enter!

Entry Information: Entries will open on Monday, November 7, and close on Friday, November 11

Entries will be taken on Saddlebook

The Divisional Finals, Permit Finals, and Junior Finals will all be one (1) run.

Entry fees: Divisional Finals: \$65 (\$55+\$10 office charge) Permit Finals: \$60 (\$50+\$10 office charge)

Junior Finals: \$60 (\$50+\$10 office charge)

Fees will be taken the weekend of the event, CASH ONLY.

You may carry your time from the Divisional Finals race to Saturday's Open race. Please make sure to select the "carry from WPRA race" option when entering the Black Friday Open (as well as any side-pots).

- Divisional Finals will have \$1,000 added and will pay 4 places.
- Junior Finals will have \$500 added and will pay 4 places
- Permit Finals will have \$500 added, payout will depend on number of entries (will payout according to pay scale in the WPRA rule book)

Turn Out Deadline: Contestants may turn out until Wednesday, November 23, at 12:00pm. You can turn out by contacting Katie Pascoe at (805) 550-8481. Permit Race contestants who turn out prior to the deadline will not be responsible for their fees. **Cardholders and Juniors ONLY:** If you turn out prior to the deadline AND a replacement is found, you will not be responsible for your entry fees. If a replacement is NOT found, you will be responsible for payment of entry fees.

Replacement procedure: Any open positions will be filled by contacting the NEXT highest ranked contestant in the 2022 standings WHO ENTERED THE DIVISIONAL FINALS.

All Contestants: Failure to turn out by the deadline (aka "Non-notified turnouts) will cause you to be responsible for entry fees, and you will also be assessed a \$50 NNTO fine, payable to the WPRA California Circuit.
